

## EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW TO VISIT THE CAVES OF SARE !

### A VISIT OUT OF TIME, IN A PRESERVED NATURAL SETTING

At the foot of the Rhune and 15km from Saint Jean de Luz.

Through a **1 hour guided tour** into the depths of the earth, discover this geological curiosity sculpted by water and feel the link that has united man and nature for thousands of years !

### ACCESS TO THE CAVES

**By car** : from highway A63, exit at Bayonne, Biarritz or St Jean de Luz North, and then follow the signs to SARE and GROTTE DE SARE.

**By bus** : with the « Saint-Jean-de-Luz - Caves of Sare » Txik Txak line.

### USEFUL INFORMATIONS :

- The number of places per visit is limited. Therefore, **we favor the advance booking of entrance tickets** (see the procedure below).
- 3 free car parks are available for cars and motorhomes ;
- Inside the cave : animals, strollers and the taking of photos/videos are not accepted. Pets are also not allowed at the bar.
- You will find a bar/café, food service (in summer), picnic area and souvenir shop.
- For those who cannot book a tour in their own language, a translation audioguide can be downloaded for free on a smartphone.
- The guided tour takes place under cover and at 14° (deep inside the cave).

#### HOW DOES IT WORK ?

1. Book online and choose your visit day and hour.
2. Download or print your **e-ticket**.
3. On the day of your visit, go to our Reception office in possession of your e-ticket, **20 minutes before the departure of your visit** (during opening hours).

### THE CAVES OF SARE ARE ALSO :



A **protected and landscaped natural site**, with a megalithic park, a picnic area and a cafe/bar.



A **guided tour with sound and lights** accompanied by one of our passionate guides !



A **preserved cave** : animals and shooting are not allowed in the cave to minimize disturbance to the flora and fauna of the site.

- **February 9th to March 29th** :  
Monday to Friday : from 2 pm to 5 pm ;  
Week-ends and holidays : from 1 pm to 5 pm.
- **March 30th to July 5th** :  
Everyday from 9:45am to 6pm.
- **July 6th to August 30th** :  
Everyday from 9:30am to 7:30pm.
- **August 31th to November 1st** :  
Everyday from 9:45am to 6pm.
- **November 2nd to January 3rd, 2027** :  
Monday to Friday : from 2 pm to 5 pm ;  
Week-ends and holidays : from 1 pm to 5 pm.

Closed on December 24th, 25th and January 1st.
